

Bachelor of Science in Nursing Program Track Application Requirements for Pre-Nursing Majors

Admission to the Bachelor of Science in Nursing program track is competitive with 80 students accepted each fall and 80 students each spring. To apply, pre-nursing majors must **1)** earn a grade of C (2.00) or above in each pre-nursing course, **2)** have a cumulative college GPA of 2.5 or above and, **3)** the courses with asterisks (**) must exceed a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.

Other Courses

UF 100, UF 200, as well as (FC) Foundations of Communications, (FA) Foundations of Arts, and (FH) Foundations of Humanities electives are not required to apply to the nursing program but must be completed to graduate with a bachelor's degree from Boise State. - The Bachelor of Science in Nursing program track is a cohort model. Admitted students from each cohort will complete a structured, 5-semester program (Semesters 4-8). Students in each cohort will progress through the program at the same rate.
- Nursing courses in Semesters 4-8 are only offered during the fall and spring semesters. Any missing Foundations or Elective courses that are not completed before students begin the Bachelor of Science in Nursing program can be completed during the fall, spring, or summer semesters.
