



Internship Guide for Environmental Studies



Start Preparing

- Complete a minimum of 58 credits before obtaining an internship
- Explore opportunities a semester prior to the experience
- Meet with the Career Center to create a strong resume and cover letter
- Use Handshake and other job searches or contact companies of interest

Application Process for Academic Credit

- Work with your supervisor to set learning objectives
- Complete the workshop and quiz on the Career Center site
- Complete your application form electronically and wait for approval
- Enroll in ENVSTD 493 once it is listed in your shopping cart

Important to Know

- Assignments are required
- Complete a minimum of 2 credits, which equates to 90-100 hours
- Boise State allows up to 12 credits of internship
- Enroll in your internship by the 10th day of classes in order to receive Financial Aid
